No. 8023. AGREEMENT¹ FOR TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SIERRA LEONE, SIGNED AT JERUSALEM, ON 22 AUGUST 1965

The Government of the State of Israel and the Government of Sierra Leone,

Animated by the desire to promote and to enlarge, to the greatest possible extent, economic and technical co-operation between the two countries ;

Mindful of the advantages to be derived from the conclusion to this end of an agreement on technical co-operation aimed at the encouragement of the exchange of knowledge and educational experience, contributing thereby towards the utilization of their economic resources, the development of their economic capacities and the greater well-being of the populations of the two countries ;

Have decided to conclude the present Agreement on Technical Co-operation and have appointed as their plenipotentiaries for this purpose :
The Government of Israel :

Mrs. Golda Meir, Minister for Foreign Affairs

The Government of Sierra Leone :

Mr. Cyril Rogers-Wright, Minister of External Affairs

who have agreed as follows :

Article I

The High Contracting Parties, taking into consideration the fundamental objectives of their respective countries, as well as the experience gained by them in the pursuit of these objectives, regard the following fields of activity as those best suited for co-operation and mutual assistance between the two countries :

1. The study of agricultural development and the training of skilled labour for the purpose of such development ;
2. The study of the problems of Public Health and the training of doctors and other medical personnel, with a view to increasing the efficiency of the health services ;
