The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Legation of Israel and with reference to the conclusion of negotiations held on October 16, 1964 in Ankara between the Delegation of Turkey and the Delegation of Israel has the honour to propose the following :

Article 1

TRAINING

Turkish teams from the Ministry of Rural Affairs will be sent to Israel in order to receive advanced training in the field of Rural Planning and Development.

The scope, terms and conditions of this training has been decided upon as follows :

A – The training will be carried out in teams composed of participants coming from one region.

B – Three teams coming from regions with similar conditions will be trained simultaneously and constitute one group.

C – The number of participants in each team will be between 8-12, depending on the final structure and organization of the Ministry of Rural Affairs.

D – Each team will be composed by Heads of regional services of the Ministry of Rural Affairs.

E – The duration of training for each group will be between 6-8 weeks.

F – In order to achieve maximum benefit from the training programme, the Ministry of Rural Affairs will do its utmost to send as many English speaking persons as possible. It is understood that each team will include at least one English speaking participant.
