No. 8039. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SENEGAL RELATING TO A UNITED NATIONS SEMINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, TO BE HELD AT DAKAR FROM 8 TO 22 FEBRUARY 1966. SIGNED AT NEW YORK, ON 12 JANUARY 1966

The United Nations and the Government of Senegal (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

1. A United Nations seminar on human rights in developing countries will be held at Dakar, Senegal.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 8 to 22 February 1966, inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for an exchange of experience and information concerning human rights in developing countries.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

Participation in the seminar shall be open to :

- (a) National participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries which are members of the Economic Commission for Africa;
- (b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations;
- (c) Representatives from any specialized agencies of the United Nations which may be invited by the United Nations to send representatives;
