Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to our recent discussions concerning proposals for an interest-free loan by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1966.

Upon instructions from Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, I now have the honour to propose to Your Excellency the following terms :

(a) The Government of the United Kingdom will advance to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan an interest-free loan of the amount of £700,000 Sterling during the financial year ending the 31st of March, 1966.

(b) The abovementioned amount will be allocated as follows :

(i) Further contribution for construction of the Kafrein and Shueib dams	£150,000
(ii) Further hydrological support for the Central Water Authority	£30,000
(iii) Contribution for drilling pilot holes for test pumping and production boreholes for Jerusalem Water Supply	£140,000
(iv) Contribution for initial phase of Wadi Dhuleil development	£50,000
(v) Agricultural Census	£60,000
(vi) Contribution for strengthening Qatrani section of the Desert Road	£15,000
