No. 8102. TREATY OF AMITY¹ BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA. SIGNED AT SEOUL, ON 27 NOVEMBER 1964

The Republic of China and the Republic of Korea, being desirous of further strengthening the friendly relations that so happily exist between the two countries and promoting the mutual interests of their peoples, have decided to conclude a Treaty of Amity, based on the principles of equality and mutual respect of sovereignty, and have, for this purpose, appointed as their Plenipotentiaries :

His Excellency the President of the Republic of China :

His Excellency Admiral Liang Hsu-chao, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of China ;

His Excellency the President of the Republic of Korea :

His Excellency Dr. Tong Won Lee, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea ;

Who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed upon the following Articles :

Article I

There shall be perpetual peace and everlasting amity between the Republic of China and the Republic of Korea as well as between their respective peoples.

Article II

The High Contracting Parties declare their firm determination to work in close and friendly collaboration for the establishment and maintenance of a world peace based on principles of justice and equality and for the promotion of economic prosperity of both peoples.

Article III

Each of the High Contracting Parties shall have the right to send duly accredited diplomatic representatives, who shall enjoy, in the country to the
