No. 8106. AGREEMENT¹ ON CULTURAL CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC
AND THE REPUBLIC OF TUNISIA. SIGNED AT
TUNIS, ON 6 APRIL 1963

The Government of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Government of the Republic of Tunisia, desiring to develop co-operation between their countries, based on mutual understanding, respect for each other's sovereignty and the principles of non-interference, in the spheres of culture, education, art and sport, thereby contributing to the strengthening of the bonds of friendship between their peoples,

Have decided to conclude the present Agreement and have for this purpose appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic :

Dr. František Kahuda, Minister of Education and Culture ;

The Government of the Republic of Tunisia :

Mr. Chédli Klibi, Secretary of State for Cultural Affairs and Information.

Article 1

The two Parties shall promote cultural and artistic exchanges between the two countries.

The two Parties also agree to exchange their knowledge and experience in the spheres of education and scientific research.

Article 2

The two Parties shall encourage co-operation between cultural, artistic, scientific and educational institutions and organizations and shall promote mutual visits by teachers, men of letters, scientists and artists.
