No. 8144. TRADE AGREEMENT³ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY. SIGNED AT DUBLIN, ON 27 JULY 1953

The Government of Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Italy desiring, by the encouragement of closer economic and commercial relations, to strengthen the bonds of friendship traditionally existing between their two peoples, have in the spirit of the Convention for European Economic Co-operation,⁴ negotiated and agreed upon the following :

Article I

The Governments of Ireland and of the Italian Republic will use their best endeavours to develop the mutual interchange of goods and services between Ireland and Italy and will foster in particular the exchange of commodities of importance to their respective economies.

Article II

The Irish Government undertake to afford all reasonable facilities for the admission to Ireland of products of Italian origin which are not liberalised and will more especially consider favourably applications for the admission of goods to the exports of which the Italian Government attach particular importance.

Article III

The Italian Government undertake to afford all reasonable facilities for the admission to Italy of products of Irish origin which are not liberalised and will more especially consider favourably applications for the admission of goods to the export of which the Irish Government attach particular importance.

Article IV

If either Government removes a commodity from its list of liberalised goods it shall, on request, consult with the other Government regarding future imports of that commodity.
