AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC CONCERNING A UNITED NATIONS SEMINAR ON PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL ADMINISTRATION AS A MEANS OF PROMOTING HUMAN RIGHTS, TO BE HELD AT BUDAPEST FROM 14 TO 27 JUNE 1966. SIGNED AT NEW YORK, ON 4 MARCH 1966

The United Nations and the Government of the Hungarian Peoples' Republic (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL ADMINISTRATION AS A MEANS OF PROMOTING HUMAN RIGHTS

1. A United Nations seminar on participation in local administration as a means of promoting human rights will be held in Budapest, Hungary.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 14 to 27 June 1966, inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for exchange of experience concerning participation in local administration as a means of promoting human rights.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

1. Participation in the seminar shall be open to :
 - (a) National participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries in Europe which are members of the United Nations or of a specialized agency;
