NO. 8174. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES RELATING TO A UNITED NATIONS SEMINAR ON MEASURES REQUIRED FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF WOMEN WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LONG-TERM PROGRAMME. SIGNED AT NEW YORK, ON 5 APRIL 1966

The United Nations and the Government of the Philippines (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON MEASURES REQUIRED FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF WOMEN WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LONG-TERM PROGRAMME

1. A United Nations seminar on measures required for the advancement of women with special reference to the establishment of a long-term programme will be held in Manila, the Philippines.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 6 to 19 December 1966, inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for exchange of experience concerning measures required for the advancement of women with special reference to the establishment of a long-term programme.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

1. Participation in the seminar shall be open to :
 - (a) Participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries and territories within the geographical scope of the Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East;
 - (b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations;
