No. 8325. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF DENMARK AND THE GOVERNMENT OF KENYA ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A WOMEN'S COLLEGE IN NAIROBI. SIGNED AT NAIROBI, ON 26 JUNE 1964

The Government of Denmark and the Government of Kenya, desirous of strengthening the friendly relations between the two countries and their peoples, and recognizing their mutual interest in the economic and technical development of their countries, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

A training Centre for African Women shall be established at the Karen House in Nairobi, formerly belonging to the late Danish authoress, Karen Blixen. The Centre will be known as Karen College.

The purpose of the Karen College will be to offer African women instruction and training in domestic and other activities which can help to make women play their due role in the process of social and economic development.

Article 2

The Danish Government, which has acquired the Karen House with 36 acres of land, agrees to place this property at the disposal of the Karen College. The Danish Government will renovate the existing building and construct necessary living accommodation as well as class-rooms, kitchens, etc.

All costs in connection with the acquisition and repair of Karen House, the costs of new construction and the costs of operating the College during a period of five years shall be borne by the Danish Government up to a maximum of Danish Kroner 1,5 million (about £75,000).

Article 3

The Danish Government will be fully responsible for the management of the College during a period of five years. The College will be managed in consultation with the interested Kenya authorities as specified in Article 8 of this Agreement.
