No. 8365. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SUDAN RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A PILOT COURSE IN PHOTOPROCESSING AND PHOTOGRAMMETRY. SIGNED AT ADDIS ABABA, ON 8 NOVEMBER 1966

The United Nations and the Government of Sudan (hereinafter referred to as "the Government"),

Desiring to provide training for Africans in photoprocessing and photogrammetry including printing reduction enlargement and rectification of aerial photographs,

Have agreed as follows :

Article I

SPONSORSHIP AND PARTICIPATION

1. A Pilot Course in Photoprocessing and Photogrammetry (hereinafter referred to as "the Pilot Course") shall be jointly sponsored by the organization and the Government in Khartoum, Sudan, from 12 November through 17 December 1966.
2. Participants in the course shall include :
 - (a) Qualified trainees from member States of the Economic Commission for Africa, selected by ECA;
 - (b) Observers nominated by member States and by the Specialized Agencies of the United Nations;
 - (c) Officials of the United Nations Secretariat named by ECA.

Article II

CO-OPERATION BY THE UNITED NATIONS

1. Subject to the availability of funds, the United Nations shall provide technical assistance as specified hereunder :
 - (a) A Director who shall be responsible, in consultation with the officer designated by the Government to serve as Co-director, for the direction and conduct of the Pilot Course and for liaison with the Government on all matters relating to the Pilot Course.
