No. 8377. AGREEMENT¹ ON CULTURAL AND SCIENTIFIC AND EDUCATIONAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AND THE IMPERIAL ETHIOPIAN GOVERNMENT. SIGNED AT ADDIS ABABA, ON 25 MAY 1965

The Government of the Hungarian People's Republic and the Imperial Ethiopian Government, led by the common desire to strengthen the friendly relations between the two countries, and to promote the co-operation in the fields of science, culture and education, have decided to conclude this Agreement and have for this purpose appointed their Plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Hungarian People's Republic :

H.E. E. Bakonyi Sebestyen, Vice-President of the National Planning Board
of the Hungarian People's Republic,

The Imperial Ethiopian Government :

H.E. Seyoum Haregot, Act/Foreign Minister,

who have exchanged their mandates, found in good and proper form, and have agreed upon the following :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties will promote the development of the scientific, educational and cultural relations between the two countries, as well as the mutual acquaintance with the achievement in the fields of science, education, culture and arts.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties will encourage the direct co-operation and exchange of experiences between the scientific, educational, cultural, artistic, health organizations and institutions of the two countries. To this end they will promote the mutual visits of University teachers and persons working in scientific or educational fields, as well as of representatives of cultural life, artists, ensembles etc.
