No. 8380. AGREEMENT OF CO-OPERATION¹ BETWEEN THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF HUNGARY AND THE REPUBLIC OF IRAQ IN THE FIELDS OF RADIO, TELEVISION, CINEMA, THEATRE AND NEWS. SIGNED AT BAGHDAD, ON 11 OCTOBER 1961

For strengthening friendly relations between the two peoples of the People's Republic of Hungary and the Republic of Iraq, and the promotion of cooperation in the fields of Radio, Television, Cinema, Theatre and News, the Governments of the two parties have decided to conclude the agreement for which purpose they nominated their authorised representatives as below :

On behalf of the People's Republic of Hungary :

Vencel Házi, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary

On behalf of the Republic of Iraq :

Ismail Arif, Minister of Guidance

Article 1

The contracting parties agreed to exchange information of achievements about their countries or peoples to be broadcasted and televised in each of the contracting countries.

Article 2

Exchanged materials must be either written and translated into English; recorded on tape, or on movie films. A short biography of the authors, producers or actors must be attached to the exchanged materials.

Article 3

The two parties agreed to exchange musical recordings at least once every three months. Other musical literature and all materials concerning radio and television will be exchanged on demand.

Article 4

The two contracting parties agreed to prepare a special programme for at least half an hour on the occasion of each other's national day, to be broadcasted
