No. 8486. REVISED AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF GUINEA AND THE UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF UNICEF IN GUINEA. SIGNED AT CONAKRY, ON 14 DECEMBER 1966, AND AT DAKAR, ON 22 DECEMBER 1966

The Government of the Republic of Guinea (hereinafter called "the Government") and the United Nations Children's Fund (hereinafter called "UNICEF"),

Whereas the General Assembly of the United Nations established UNICEF as an organ of the United Nations for the purpose of meeting, through the provision of supplies, training and advice, emergency and long-range needs of children, and their continuing needs particularly in developing countries, with a view to strengthening, where appropriate, the permanent child welfare and practical training programmes of countries receiving assistance ;

Whereas the Government desires UNICEF co-operation for the above purposes ;

Have entered into this revised Agreement.

Article I

REQUESTS TO UNICEF AND PLANS OF OPERATIONS

1. This Agreement establishes the basic conditions and the mutual undertakings governing projects in which UNICEF and the Government are participating.
2. Whenever the Government wishes to obtain the co-operation of UNICEF, it shall inform UNICEF in writing, giving a description of the proposed project and the extent of the proposed participation of the Government and UNICEF in its execution.
3. UNICEF shall consider such requests on the basis of its available resources, its assistance policies and the need for assistance.
