No. 8521. PUBLIC OFFICERS AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF
GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUYANA. SIGNED AT GEORGE-
TOWN, ON 26 MAY 1966

Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom and the Government of Guyana have agreed as follows :

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Agreement —
- (a) “ the appointed day ” means the 26th May, 1966 ;
 - (b) “ conditions of service ” means the laws, rules, regulations, orders and other instruments that regulate the terms of service of an officer relating to his tenure of office, disciplinary control, salary (including salary scales), pensionable allowances and passages ;
 - (c) “ officer ” means an officer who was before the appointed day the substantive holder of a pensionable office in the Public Service of British Guiana being a person —
 - (i) who was selected for or offered appointment to the Public Service of British Guiana by a Secretary of State ; or
 - (ii) whose appointment to the Public Service of British Guiana was approved by a Secretary of State ; or
 - (iii) who had entered into an agreement with the Crown Agents for Oversea Governments and Administrations to serve in the Public Service of British Guiana ; or
 - (iv) who (although not an officer falling within heads (i), (ii) or (iii) of this subparagraph) is or has been a member of Her Majesty's Overseas Civil Service or Her Majesty's Overseas Judiciary, or has been a member of a former Colonial Unified Service, or is or was a designated officer for the purposes of the Overseas Service (British Guiana) Agreement 1961 ;
