No. 8522. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF FINLAND RELATING TO A UNITED NATIONS SEMINAR ON THE CIVIC AND POLITICAL EDUCATION OF WOMEN, TO BE HELD AT HELSINKI FROM 1 TO 14 AUGUST 1967. SIGNED AT HELSINKI, ON 7 DECEMBER 1966, AND AT NEW YORK, ON 16 JANUARY 1967

The United Nations and the Government of Finland (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON THE CIVIC AND POLITICAL EDUCATION OF WOMEN

1. A United Nations seminar on the civic and political education of women will be held in Helsinki, Finland.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 1 to 14 August 1967.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

1. Participation in the seminar shall be open to :
 - (a) Participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries invited to the seminar ;
 - (b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations ;
 - (c) Representatives from specialized agencies of the United Nations which may be invited by the United Nations to send representatives ;
