EXCHANGE OF LETTERS CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (SPECIAL FUND), THE UNITED NATIONS, THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION, THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS, THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION, THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION, THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION, THE INTERNATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATION UNION, THE WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION, THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY, THE UNIVERSAL POSTAL UNION AND THE INTER-GOVERNMENTAL MARITIME CONSULTATIVE ORGANIZATION, ON THE ONE HAND, AND INDONESIA, ON THE OTHER HAND, BY WHICH THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL FUND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF INDONESIA CONCERNING ASSISTANCE FROM THE SPECIAL FUND, SIGNED AT DJAKARTA ON 7 OCTOBER 1960,² AND THE REVISED BASIC AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE ORGANIZATIONS MEMBERS OF THE UNITED NATIONS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE BOARD AND THE GOVERNMENT OF INDONESIA, SIGNED AT DJAKARTA ON 29 OCTOBER 1954,³ ARE DEEMED REVIVED AND APPLICABLE TO ACTIVITIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME IN INDONESIA SUBJECT, AS REGARDS THE SECOND OF THOSE AGREEMENTS, TO CERTAIN AMENDMENTS THERETO. Sir,

I have the honour to refer to your letter of 3 October 1966 in which you request that the provision of assistance to Indonesia under the constituent sectors of the United Nations Development Programme should be resumed.

As you are aware, the agreement entered into on 7 October 1960¹ by your Government and the Special Fund, as well as the agreement entered into on 29 October 1954² between your Government and the Organizations participating in the expanded programme of Technical Assistance, were terminated with effect on 18 and 17 May 1965 by exchange of letters dated 10 March and 8 April 1965, and 10 March and 30 March 1965, respectively, between your Government and the then executive heads of the constituent sectors of the United Nations Development Programme. In order to provide a basis for the resumption of activities of the United Nations Development Programme in Indonesia, I have the honour to propose as an interim measure that these agreements should be deemed revived and should apply to activities of the programme in your country subject, in the case of the agreement concluded on 29 October 1954, to the amendments set out in the attachment hereto. This arrangement would remain in force until such time as your Government and the United Nations Development Programme conclude a new agreement to take the place of those referred to above.

If your Government should find the foregoing proposals acceptable, I should be grateful to receive its reply to that effect. This letter together with your reply will then be deemed to constitute an agreement in the matter between your Government and the United Nations Development Programme.
