No. 8536. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND AND ZAMBIA CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF UNICEF IN ZAMBIA. SIGNED AT LUSAKA, ON 24 JANUARY 1967, AND AT KAMPALA, ON 2 FEBRUARY 1967

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the General Assembly of the United Nations established UNICEF as an organ of the United Nations for the purpose of meeting, through the provision of supplies, training and advice, emergency and long-range needs of children, and their continuing needs, particularly in developing countries, with a view to strengthening, where appropriate, the permanent child health and child welfare programmes of countries receiving assistance ; and

WHEREAS the Government of Zambia desires UNICEF co-operation for the above purposes ;

The United Nations Children's Fund (hereinafter called " UNICEF ") and the Government of Zambia (hereinafter called " the Government ") have entered into this Agreement.

Article I

REQUESTS TO UNICEF AND PLANS OF OPERATIONS

1. This Agreement establishes the basic conditions and the mutual undertakings governing projects in which UNICEF and the Government are participating.
2. Whenever the Government wishes to obtain the co-operation of UNICEF, it shall inform UNICEF in writing, giving a description of the proposed project and the extent of the proposed participation of the Government and UNICEF in its execution.
3. UNICEF shall consider such requests on the basis of its available resources, its assistance policies and the need for assistance.
4. The terms and conditions for each agreed project, including the commitments of the Government and UNICEF with respect to the furnishing of
