No. 8622. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE SOCIALIST FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF AUSTRIA CONCERNING ALPINE TOURIST TRAFFIC IN THE FRONTIER REGION. SIGNED AT EISENSTADT, ON 10 OCTOBER 1966

The Government of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Federal Government of the Republic of Austria, desiring to promote good neighbourly relations, have agreed to conclude the following Agreement concerning Alpine tourist traffic in the frontier region :

Article 1

Yugoslav and Austrian nationals bearing a valid passport or a frontier document for minor frontier traffic may cross the Yugoslav-Austrian frontier at the frontier crossing points referred to below and proceed in the territory of the other Contracting State, using only the designated routes in both directions, to the following mountain peaks and mountain huts :

1. In the region of the Peca (Petzen) : in Yugoslav territory from the shelter on the Peca (Planinski dom na Peci) to the Kordeževa Glava (Kordeschkopf) frontier crossing point, Mark 2126, and thereafter in Austrian territory to the Siebenhütten.
2. In the region of the Stol (Hochstuhl) : in Yugoslav territory, from the Prešernova Koča or from the Veliki Stol to the Sedlo Belščica (Bielschitzza-Sattel) frontier crossing point, Mark 1840, and thereafter in Austrian territory by way of the Klagenfurter Hütte to the Matschacher Alm.

Article 2

(1) The Kordeževa Glava (Kordeschkopf) frontier crossing point may be used only from 15 April to 15 October, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 5 p.m.

(2) The Sedlo Belščica (Bielschitzza-Sattel) frontier crossing point may be used only from 15 April to 15 November, between sunrise and sunset.

(3) The said frontier crossing points may be used at times other than those specified in paragraphs (1) and (2) only in cases of *force majeure*.
