EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF AUSTRIA, THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND CONCERNING THE COMMONWEALTH WAR CEMETERY AT KLAGENFURT. Your Excellency,

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the Government of New Zealand are desirous of concluding an Agreement with the Austrian Federal Government on the status of the Commonwealth War Cemetery at Klagenfurt, Carinthia.

2. Accordingly, I now have the honour to propose an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom, acting on their own behalf and on behalf of the Government of New Zealand, and the Austrian Federal Government, in the following terms:

(i) The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of New Zealand inform the Austrian Federal Government that the Commonwealth War Graves Commission is the sole organisation authorised by the said Governments to care for the Commonwealth War Cemetery at Klagenfurt, Carinthia.

(ii) The Austrian Federal Government recognizes the Commonwealth War Graves Commission as being authorised to discharge the task delegated to it under sub-paragraph (i) of the present Agreement, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 19 of the State Treaty for the Re-establishment of an Independent and Democratic Austria concluded on the 15th of May, 1955, between the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the United States of America and France, of the one part, and Austria, of the other part.

(iii) The Austrian Federal Government grants to the Commonwealth War Graves Commission free of cost the permanent use of the state-owned land de-
