No. 8744. AGREEMENT¹ ON SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL
CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC
OF ROMANIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF TUNISIA. SIGN-
ED AT BUCHAREST, ON 21 APRIL 1966

The Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania and the Government of the Republic of Tunisia, prompted by the desire to foster and consolidate friendly relations between their countries and to establish the bases for scientific and technical co-operation, have decided to conclude this Agreement and have for that purpose appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

For the Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania, Mr. Vasile Gliga, Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs ;

For the Government of the Republic of Tunisia, Mr. Mahmoud Maamouri, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Tunisia to the Socialist Republic of Romania ;

who have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties undertake to co-operate in the fields of science and technology, on the basis of mutual respect for the principles of sovereignty, equality of rights, reciprocal advantage and non-interference in the domestic affairs of the other country and to utilize the latest achievements of science and technology in the most effective manner in the economic development of the two countries.

Article 2

Scientific and technical co-operation between the Contracting Parties shall include :

1. The exchange of information and documentation in the fields of science, technology and agriculture ;
2. The exchange of experts, specialists and technicians in the fields of science, technology and agriculture ;
3. The exchange of fellowship-holders and trainees in the field of education ;
