No. 8764. AGREEMENT ¹ FOR SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF ROMANIA. SIGNED AT LONDON, ON 9 MARCH 1967

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Socialist Republic of Rumania ;

Desirous of advancing further the friendly relations between them and of promoting scientific and technological co-operation between their countries :

Have agreed as follows :

Article I

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Socialist Republic of Rumania shall encourage and develop scientific and technological co-operation between their two countries on a basis of mutual benefit, and shall use their best endeavours to this end within the terms of this Agreement.

Article II

The Contracting Governments shall seek to promote on a mutual basis by the means most appropriate :

- (a) Visits of experts and technicians for studies, training, consultations and exchange of views in the scientific and technological fields.
- (b) Facilities for study and research and opportunities to gain experience in industrial research institutes and industrial enterprises.
- (c) The exchange between industrial enterprises in the two countries of industrial knowledge and technology, including arrangements in the field of licences.
- (d) Arrangements for the exchange of scientific and technical information.
- (e) Such other forms of co-operation in science and technology as may be mutually agreed.
