No. 8817. AGREEMENT¹ ON CO-OPERATION IN THE
FIELD OF RADIO AND TELEVISION BETWEEN THE
UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AND THE
KINGDOM OF MOROCCO. SIGNED AT MOSCOW, ON
27 OCTOBER 1966

The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco, desiring to develop co-operation between their countries in the field of radio and television, on the basis of mutual understanding, of respect for sovereignty and for the principle of non-interference in internal affairs, and of equality, thereby contributing to the strengthening of friendly relations between their peoples, have decided to conclude this Agreement.

The Parties have for this purpose appointed their Plenipotentiaries:
The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: A. A. Gromyko,
Minister for Foreign Affairs,

The Government of the Kingdom of Morocco: Mohammed Cherkaoui, Minister for Foreign Affairs,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

I. RADIO

Article 1

The Committee for Radio and Television of the Council of Ministers of the USSR and the Radio and Television Department of the Kingdom of Morocco shall regularly exchange:

- programmes on social and political questions, sports, literature and science and programmes for children and young people;
- programmes on the activities of women's organizations;
- reports, interviews and other material of mutual interest.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties shall exchange musical works of all kinds recorded on tape:
