No. 8982. AGREEMENT¹ FOR CO-OPERATION BETWEEN
THE BULGARIAN TELEVISION AND THE UNITED
ARAB REPUBLIC TELEVISION. SIGNED AT CAIRO,
ON 12 FEBRUARY 1967

According to Article 8 of the Cultural Agreement signed in Cairo on October 19th, 1957² and Article 7 of the executive programme for 1965 and 1966, signed in Cairo on November 17th, 1965, and in view of strengthening and developing the co-operation in the field of culture between the peoples of Bulgaria and the United Arab Republic, the Bulgarian Television and the U.A.R. Television agreed on the following:

Article 1

The two contracting parties shall regularly exchange :

- a) present day news on 16 or 35 mm band reflecting the economic, cultural and sport life of the two countries at least once a month;
- b) film sketches and reports, documentary and popular scientific short films, children's films, musical and amusing film programmes, concerts etc.;
- c) all material mentioned in a) and b) shall be accompanied by an explanatory text either in English or French.

Article 2

On the occasion of the National days of the People's Republic of Bulgaria—September 9th—and the United Arab Republic—23rd July—the two parties shall send each other television programmes reflecting the national days. The programmes shall be sent one month in advance.

Article 3

The two parties shall co-operate within their possibilities in the field of joint production of television films. The details in this respect shall be defined in special agreements for every individual case.

Article 4

The contracting parties shall annually exchange experts on television, aiming at the exchange of experience and strengthening of co-operation. The receiving
