No. 9000. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ZAMBIA CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF NETHERLANDS VOLUNTEERS IN ZAMBIA. SIGNED AT LUSAKA, ON 17 DECEMBER 1965

The Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, and the Government of the Republic of Zambia,

Desirous of collaborating in the development of Zambia and of placing at the disposal of the Zambian Government Netherlands volunteers within the framework of the Netherlands Youth Volunteers Programme,

Inspired with the desire to conclude an Agreement to this end,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

a) Under the Netherlands Youth Volunteers Programme and within the limits imposed by the availability of manpower and financial and material resources, the Netherlands Government shall place Netherlands volunteers at the disposal of the Zambian Government upon the request of the latter.

b) Netherlands volunteers shall be made available on the conditions specified in this Agreement and in accordance with any special regulations to be agreed upon as the need arises. Prior agreement between the two Governments shall be reached in respect of the tasks to be carried out by the Netherlands volunteers.

Article 2

The object of making Netherlands volunteers available is to help train staff by co-operating with the intermediate and lower categories of staff in Zambia.

Article 3

a) The Netherlands volunteers shall work under the direct supervision of persons or bodies designated by the Zambian Government to carry out the projects decided upon, which persons or bodies shall be responsible for the effective employment of the volunteers.

b) The Netherlands Government reserves the right to send representatives to see how the work agreed upon progresses and for any other purposes relating to said work.
