No. 9055. TREATY ¹ OF FRIENDSHIP AND SOLIDARITY
BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO AND THE
REPUBLIC OF SENEGAL. SIGNED AT RABAT, ON 15
SEPTEMBER 1966

The Government of the Kingdom of Morocco and

The Government of the Republic of Senegal

Having regard to the long-standing bonds of friendship existing between Morocco and Senegal ;

Desirous of achieving the objectives of the Charter of the Organization of African Unity ² relating to the intensification of co-operation between member States ;

Gratified at the progress made in co-operation between the two States, as a result of the cultural and commercial agreements and the Convention on Establishment concluded between the two countries,

Wishing to strengthen this fruitful co-operation within the context of a policy of association, as proclaimed in the joint Moroccan-Senegalese communiqué which was issued at the conclusion of the talks held at Marrakesh on 23 and 24 May 1966 between His Majesty Hassan II, King of Morocco, and His Excellency Mr. Léopold Sédar Senghor, President of the Republic of Senegal ;

Have agreed upon the following provisions :

Article 1

A Moroccan-Senegalese Inter-State Ministerial Committee shall be established with a view to strengthening and expanding co-operation and solidarity between the two countries.

Article 2

The two Heads of State shall, whenever they deem it necessary, meet in conference alternately at Rabat and Dakar with a view to examining the international situation and reviewing the development of Moroccan-Senegalese co-operation.
