No. 9144. BASIC AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF BOTSWANA. SIGNED AT KAMPALA, ON 24 MAY 1968, AND AT GABERONES, ON 25 JUNE 1968

Preamble

WHEREAS the General Assembly of the United Nations established UNICEF as an organ of the United Nations for the purpose of meeting, through the provision of supplies, training and advice, emergency and long-range needs of children, and their continuing needs, particularly in developing countries, with a view to strengthening, where appropriate, the permanent child health and child welfare programmes of countries receiving assistance ; and

WHEREAS the Government of Botswana desires UNICEF cooperation for the above purposes ;

The United Nations Children's Fund (hereinafter called " UNICEF ") and the Government of Botswana (hereinafter called " the Government ") have entered into this Agreement.

Article I

REQUESTS TO UNICEF AND PLANS OF OPERATIONS

1. This Agreement establishes the basic conditions and the mutual undertakings governing projects in which UNICEF and the Government are participating.
2. Whenever the Government wishes to obtain the cooperation of UNICEF, it shall inform UNICEF in writing, giving a description of the proposed project and the extent of the proposed participation of the Government and UNICEF in its execution.
3. UNICEF shall consider such requests on the basis of its available resources, its assistance policies and the need for assistance.
