No. 9189. CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF KUWAIT. SIGNED AT KUWAIT, ON 27 MARCH 1967

The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Government of the State of Kuwait;

Seeking the progressive development of friendly relations and mutual understanding between their countries;

And being guided by the desire to expand and strengthen cultural co-operation on the basis of the principles of mutual respect, equality of rights and non-intervention of either country in the affairs of the other;

Have decided to conclude this agreement, and appointed for this purpose their respective plenipotentiaries :

For the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics :

H. E. Micheil F. Bodroof, Ambassador of U.S.S.R. in Kuwait.

For the Government of the State of Kuwait :

H. E. Saleh Abdul-Malek Al-Saleh, Minister of Education.

Who after having exchanged their Full Powers which were found to be in good and due form;

Have agreed to the following :

Article I

Each of the contracting parties shall, as far as possible, mutually encourage educational, scientific and cultural co-operation between the two countries through such means as the following :

(a) Exchange of University professors, instructors and persons engaged in scientific, technical and cultural research including provision of the necessary facilities for all such persons;

(b) The sharing by university graduates, scientists and scholars of each country in training programmes and courses of vocational training in the other country including provision of the facilities necessary for this purpose;
