No. 9197. CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE
KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND BRAZIL.
SIGNED AT THE HAGUE, ON 12 OCTOBER 1966

The Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and

The Government of the Republic of the United States of Brazil,

Desiring to strengthen the traditional ties of friendship and the educational, scientific and artistic relations between the two countries,

Have decided to conclude an Agreement concerning cultural relations and, to this end, have appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands :

His Excellency Mr. J. M. A. H. Luns, Minister for Foreign Affairs;

The Government of the Republic of the United States of Brazil :

His Excellency Mr. Jayme Sloan Chermont, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary,

Who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article I

In order to promote in each country a better understanding of the other country's culture, the Contracting Parties shall, so far as possible, assist each other by means of :

- (a) The dissemination of books, periodicals and other publications;
- (b) The organization of lectures, concerts and theatrical performances;
- (c) The organization of art exhibitions and other cultural exhibitions;
- (d) The organization of radio programmes, the dissemination of gramophone records and the use of similar media;
- (e) The showing of scientific, educational and cultural films;
- (f) The exchange of copies of such documents belonging to the official archives and libraries of either country as may be of interest to the other country, provided that such exchange does not violate the law of either country.

¹ Came into force on 29 May 1968 by the exchange of the instruments of ratification, which took place at Rio de Janeiro, in accordance with article IX.
