Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Letters signed respectively at Wellington on 31 August 1959 and at Suva on 21 September 1959, ² constituting an Agreement between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of Fiji concerning financial arrangements for the defence of Fiji. As you know, the 1959 Agreement was subsequently amended by the Agreement constituted by an Exchange of Letters signed respectively at Wellington on 24 March 1964 and at Suva on 4 April 1964. ³

I now have the honour to make the following proposals for a new Agreement which would replace the 1959 Agreement as amended by the 1964 Agreement on this subject :

1. The Government of Fiji shall, from 1 January 1967, meet all capital expenditure incurred for the purposes of the defence of Fiji. In this connection, " capital expenditure " means all expenditure on fixed assets, and includes expenditure on the purchase of any motor vehicles other than normal replacements.
