No. 9261. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE REPUBLIC OF THE NIGER FOR CO-OPERATION IN THE FIELD OF RADIO BROADCASTING. SIGNED AT NIAMEY, ON 25 FEBRUARY 1967

Between the Government of the French Republic, represented by Mr. Jean Charbonnel, Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs in charge of Co-operation, of the one part, and

The Government of the Republic of the Niger, represented by Mr. Diori Hamani, President of the Republic of the Niger, of the other part,

It has been agreed as follows :

Article 1

The French Republic and the Republic of the Niger agree to establish relationships of co-operation in the field of sound and visual radio broadcasting in accordance with the terms hereinafter specified.

Article 2

The High Contracting Parties undertake to use their radio broadcasting systems to promote better understanding between the two countries and to disseminate their common culture.

For this purpose the French Republic shall, through the Office of Radio Co-operation (Office de Coopération Radiophonique), supply French-language programmes of all kinds (recordings, sound and visual material, productions, records, etc.) to the Republic of the Niger, which shall arrange for them to be broadcast regularly over its entire network within the framework of its national broadcasting programmes. The French Republic shall, likewise, endeavour to arrange for the material, records, productions and programmes supplied to it by the Republic of the Niger to be broadcast as widely as possible over its own network and those of other States to which it is offering its co-operation.

Article 3

The Office of Radio Co-operation shall be at the disposal of the Republic of the Niger for the following purposes :

—To provide training for the personnel of its national broadcasting system;
