No. 9305. AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE ROYAL DANISH GOVERNMENT AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA ON VOLUNTEERS FROM DENMARK. SIGNED AT KAMPALA, ON 3 JULY 1968

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The Royal Danish Government and the Government of the Republic of Uganda desirous of collaborating in the development of Uganda and of placing at the disposal of the Government of Uganda Danish Volunteers within the frame-work of the Danish Development Service and inspired with the desire to conclude an agreement to this end have agreed as follows :

*Article 1*

The Government of Denmark, represented by the Danish Association for International Co-operation (hereinafter called the Association), will furnish such Danish volunteers as may be agreed upon by the Government of the Republic of Uganda and the Association to perform mutually agreed tasks in Uganda. The number of Danish volunteers as well as their assignments in Uganda are to be agreed upon by separate exchange of letters between the Government of the Republic of Uganda and the Association.

*Article 2*

The Danish volunteers will work under the supervision of Governmental or other institutions in Uganda as agreed upon by the two parties.

*Article 3*

The volunteers will serve in Uganda for a period of two years in the first instance. During their assignment the volunteers will be entitled to three weeks annual leave.

*Article 4*

To enable the Association to discharge its responsibilities in Uganda under this programme the Government of the Republic of Uganda is ready to receive a Resident Representative of the Association and necessary staff.

*Article 5*

The Association undertakes to :

1. (a) provide introductory training of the volunteers before their arrival in Uganda ;

(b) cover the transportation costs for the volunteers, the Resident Representative and members of the staff between Denmark and Uganda ;

(c) cover their emoluments during their assignment in Uganda, hereunder living allowance, leave allowance and outfit allowance ;

(d) provide a limited number of motor vehicles, as needed to enable the Resident Representative, members of his staff and volunteers, to perform their duties. The vehicles will remain the property of the Association ;

(e) cover their insurance expenditures, hereunder health, public liability, and accident.

2. The Association further undertakes that the volunteers who are the subject matter of this Agreement shall obey the Laws of Uganda which are not inconsistent with the terms of this Agreement.

*Article 6*

1. The Government of the Republic of Uganda undertakes that the Resident Representative, members of this staff and volunteers shall :

(a) be exempt from legal process in respect of words spoken or written and all acts performed by them in their official capacity ;

(b) be exempt from national service obligation ;

(c) be exempt together with their spouses and dependents, from immigration restrictions and alien registration ;

(d) be accorded the same privileges in respect of exchange control facilities as are accorded to the technical assistance personnel of the other countries of comparable rank serving in Uganda ;

(e) be provided by the Government of the Republic of Uganda with a document identifying them and promising them full assistance by appropriate national authorities in the performance of the tasks assigned to them.

2. The Government of the Republic of Uganda shall hold harmless the Government of Denmark and Volunteers against any and all bonafide liabilities arising out of Clause 1 (a) of this Article.
