CULTURAL CONVENTION ¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND
NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF
THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the United Arab Republic;

Desiring to promote friendly relationships and to increase cultural co-operation between their two countries;

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

This Convention shall apply:

- (a) in relation to the Government of the United Kingdom, to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; and
- (b) in relation to the Government of the United Arab Republic, to the United Arab Republic.

Article II

The Contracting Governments shall mutually encourage and promote to the maximum extent educational, scientific and cultural co-operation between the two countries through such means as the following:

- (a) the exchange of university professors, instructors and persons engaged in scientific and technical research including provision of the necessary facilities for all such persons;
- (b) the awarding of scholarships to university graduates, qualified scientists and technologists and research scholars from each country for study, research and training in the other country, including provision of the facilities necessary for such study, research and training;
