TREATY¹ OF FRIENDSHIP AND CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE MONGOLIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AND THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC

The Mongolian People's Republic and the German Democratic Republic,

Noting that the friendly co-operation in the political, economic and cultural field based on the Treaty of Friendship and Co-operation of 22 August 1957² between the Mongolian People's Republic and the German Democratic Republic has brought fruitful results beneficial to the peoples of both States,

Desirous of continuing to develop and strengthen fraternal friendship and relations of comprehensive co-operation and comradely assistance between the Mongolian People's Republic and the German Democratic Republic on the basis of socialist internationalism,

Convinced that developing their relations in that manner serves the vital interests of both States and helps to strengthen the unity of the socialist community,

Being at one in the conviction that the German Democratic Republic—the socialist State of the German nation—which embodies the principles of the Potsdam Agreement, is an important factor in safeguarding peace and that its active peace-loving policy and its participation on a footing of equality in international co-operation are of great importance in establishing a durable system of European security,

Firmly resolved to oppose the threat to peace presented by the reactionary forces, in particular the aggressive policy of United States imperialism and West German militarism and revanchism and the latter's claim to represent the German people,
