AGREEMENT ¹ FOR CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF ROMANIA

The Government of the Argentine Republic and

The Government of the Socialist Republic of Romania,

Desiring to strengthen the bonds of friendship between the peoples of the two countries,

Desiring to promote greater co-operation and a greater knowledge of the affinities of the two peoples and of the progress made by them in the fields of science, education, art, culture and sports,

Convinced that such co-operation will at the same time help to strengthen the bonds of friendship between them,

Have decided, on the basis of mutual respect for the principles of their sovereignty, of equal rights, of non-interference in domestic affairs and to the reciprocal benefit of each High Contracting Party, to conclude this Agreement and for this purpose have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries:

His Excellency The President of the Argentine Nation, Lieutenant-General Juan Carlos Onganía: Mr. Nicanor Costa Méndez, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Public Worship;

His Excellency The Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Socialist Republic of Romania, Mr. Ion Gheorghe Maurer: Mr. Corneliu Manescu, Minister for Foreign Affairs;

Who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

Article I

The two Contracting Parties undertake, on the basis of respect for the principles of sovereignty and independence, of non-interference in domestic affairs and of full reciprocity, to develop co-operation in the fields of science, art and literature.
