Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the request of the Government of Botswana for the provision by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland of personnel of the United Kingdom armed forces to assist in the training of the police forces of Botswana.

I have the honour to propose that the arrangements for the provision of such personnel should be those set out in the Appendix to this letter.

I have the honour further to propose that if these arrangements are acceptable to the Government of Botswana this Letter and its Appendix, together with your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement in this matter between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Botswana which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 1 March, 1968 and shall continue in force until determined by the giving by either Government to the other of written notice of determination, whereupon this Agreement shall forthwith determine except any provisions thereof relating to the treatment of claims and the financial obligations of either Government, which provisions shall remain in force.
