Taipei, March 14, 1967

Excellency:

I have the honor to refer to your Government's request for the loan of a naval vessel and to propose that the vessel listed in the annex hereto be loaned upon the understanding that the terms and conditions of loan applicable to the aforementioned vessel shall be those specified in the agreement effected by an exchange of Notes signed at Taipei on February 7, 1959.²

If the foregoing understanding is acceptable to your Government, I further have the honor to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's Note in reply concurring therein shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply Note.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
