Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions concerning assistance by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as the Government of the United Kingdom) to His Majesty's Government of Nepal (hereinafter referred to as the Government of Nepal) towards the construction in Nepal of a sector of the Mahendra Raj Marg (otherwise known as the East-West Highway), and to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom are prepared to conclude an Agreement with the Government of Nepal on this question. The commitments of the Government of the United Kingdom and of the Government of Nepal shall be as respectively set out in Part A and Part B below:

A. The Government of the United Kingdom declare that it is their intention, acting by the Ministry of Overseas Development, to provide assistance to the Government of Nepal towards the costs of designing and constructing that part of the Mahendra Raj Marg running from the West bank of the Narayani River, near
