No. 627. AGREEMENT¹ ON CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE INTER-GOVERNMENTAL MARITIME CONSULTATIVE ORGANIZATION AND THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS. SIGNED AT LONDON, ON 8 JULY 1966, AND AT ROME, ON 11 JULY 1966

Whereas the Constitution of the Food and Agriculture Organization (hereinafter referred to as FAO) provides that the Organization may enter into agreements with other international organizations with related activities in order to define methods of co-operation ; and

Whereas the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization² (hereinafter referred to as IMCO) provides that the Organization shall co-operate with any specialized agency of the United Nations in matters which may be the common concern of the Organization and of such specialized agency, and shall consider such matters and act with respect to them in accord with such specialized agency ;

FAO and IMCO agree as follows :

Article I

CO-OPERATION AND CONSULTATION

FAO and IMCO agree that with a view to facilitating the effective attainment of the objectives set forth in the Constitution of FAO and the Convention on IMCO within the general framework established by the Charter of the United Nations, they will act in close co-operation with each other and will consult each other regularly in regard to matters of common interest.

Article II

RECIPROCAL REPRESENTATION

1. Representatives of FAO shall be invited to attend the meetings of the IMCO Assembly and to participate without vote in the deliberations of the Assembly and of its commissions and committees with respect to items on their agenda in which FAO has an interest.

¹ In accordance with article XIII, the Agreement came into force on 1 December 1965, the date on which the Conference of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations confirmed, in resolution 18/65, the approval of the Agreement given previously by the Council of that Organization, the Assembly of the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization having approved the Agreement on 27 September 1965 in resolution A.103 (IV).
