AGREEMENT ¹ BETWEEN THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY AND THE UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION CONCERNING THE JOINT OPERATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR THEORETICAL PHYSICS AT TRIESTE

WHEREAS an Agreement for co-operation between the International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter called the "Agency") and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (hereinafter called "UNESCO" ²) has been in force since 1 October 1958;

WHEREAS both organizations are concerned with the development of the physical sciences in their Member States and particularly in the developing countries;

WHEREAS the Agency has operated the International Centre for Theoretical Physics at Trieste (hereinafter called the "Centre") since 1964 ³ and has received valuable contributions from UNESCO to this project;

WHEREAS both organizations have expressed their willingness to operate the Centre jointly and to make equal contributions to the operating costs of the Centre;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agency and UNESCO have agreed as follows:

Article I

PRINCIPLES OF COLLABORATION

Section 1. The Centre's scientific activities will constitute a joint programme carried out by both organizations in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. They agree to maintain the purpose and functions of the Centre as set forth in Sections 2 and 3 of this Agreement.
