AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH

WHEREAS the United Nations Children's Fund (hereinafter called "UNICEF") was established by the General Assembly of the United Nations as an organ of the United Nations for the purpose of meeting, through the provision of supplies, training and advice, emergency and long-range needs of children, and their continuing needs particularly in developing countries, with a view to strengthening, where appropriate, the permanent child health and child welfare programmes of countries receiving assistance; and

WHEREAS the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (hereinafter called "the Government") desires UNICEF co-operation for the above purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, UNICEF and the Government agree as follows:

Article I. REQUESTS TO UNICEF AND PLANS OF OPERATIONS

1. This Agreement establishes the basic conditions and the mutual undertakings governing projects in which UNICEF and the Government are participating.

2. Whenever the Government wishes to obtain the co-operation of UNICEF, it shall inform UNICEF in writing, giving a description of the proposed project and the extent of the proposed participation of the Government and UNICEF in its execution.

3. UNICEF shall consider such requests on the basis of its available resources, its assistance policies and the need for assistance.

4. The terms and conditions for each agreed project, including the commitments of the Government and UNICEF with respect to the furnishing of supplies, equipment, services or other assistance, shall be set forth in plans of operations to be signed by the Government and UNICEF, and when appropriate, by other organizations participating in the project. The provisions of this Agreement shall apply to each plans of operations.

Article II. USE OF SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT AND OTHER ASSISTANCE FURNISHED BY UNICEF

1. Supplies and equipment furnished by UNICEF shall be transferred to the Government upon arrival in the country, except as, in the case of transport or large items of equipment, may be otherwise provided in the plans of operations. UNICEF reserves the right to require the return of any
