Sir,

I am instructed by the Belgian Government to propose to Your Excellency the conclusion by a simple exchange of notes of a new arrangement rescinding and replacing the Belgian-Luxembourg Agreement which came into force on 1 August 1949 concerning the movement of persons between Belgium and the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

The text of the note in question, reproduced below, has been approved by Your Excellency, as you were kind enough to inform me in your communication of 29 March 1950.

“ 1. *Belgian nationals*, whatever their country of residence, may enter and leave the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg by any of the frontiers, provided that they are in possession of one of the following documents :

“ (a) a national passport, even if it has expired, provided that it was issued or renewed after 1 October 1944;

“ (b) a Belgian identity card, the validity of which has not expired, and which was issued or renewed after 6 October 1944;

This Agreement cancels and supersedes :
