AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TUNISIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC IN THE FIELD OF RESIDENCE AND EMPLOYMENT

The Government of the Republic of Tunisia and

The Government of the French Republic,

Confirming their commitment to the principles set forth in the Labour Agreement of 9 August 1963² and in the Agreement on Economic Relations and the Protection of Investments, as well as in the two exchanges of letters of the same date³ annexed thereto,

Desiring to regulate on a fair and lasting basis the status of French nationals in Tunisia and of Tunisian nationals in France with respect to residence and employment,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

Tunisian nationals regularly residing in France who, on the date of the entry into force of this Agreement, are holders of a residence permit valid for a period of three years or more shall, upon expiry of the permit which they hold, receive as of right a residence permit valid for 10 years.

Such permit shall be renewable, as of right, for a period of 10 years and shall entitle the holder to reside in the territory of the French Republic and to engage in any salaried or unsalaried occupation, including a commercial occupation, in the European departments of France.

Tunisian nationals residing in France who provide proof of regular residence for a period of less than three years on the date of the entry into force of this Agreement shall have the period of their residence taken into account for the purposes of the application of the provisions of this Agreement, particularly with respect to the issuance of a residence and work permit valid for 10 years.

Article 2

French nationals residing in Tunisia who provide proof of regular residence for three years or more on the date of the entry into force of this Agreement shall be entitled, as of right, to a residence permit valid for a period of 10 years entitling them to reside in the territory of the Republic of Tunisia, as well as to a work permit valid for the same period allowing them to engage in any salaried or unsalaried occupation, including a commercial occupation.

Upon their expiry, such residence and work permits shall be renewable as of right for a period of 10 years.

Pending the replacement of the permits which they currently hold, the French nationals referred to in the first paragraph of this article shall enjoy the rights attached to possession of a residence permit valid for 10 years and the right to engage in the occupation of their choice.

French nationals residing in Tunisia who provide proof of regular residence for a period of less than three years on the date of the entry into force of this Agreement shall have the period of their residence taken into account for the purposes of the application of the provisions of this Agreement, particularly with respect to the issuance of a residence and work permit valid for 10 years.

Article 3

Tunisian nationals who wish to engage in a salaried occupation in France for a period of at least one year and who are not covered by the provisions of article 1 of this Agreement shall, after undergoing a medical examination and on presentation of a contract of employment stamped by the competent authorities, receive a residence permit valid for one year which shall be renewable and bear the word "salaried".

After three years of regular residence in France, the Tunisian nationals referred to in the preceding paragraph may obtain a residence permit valid for 10 years. Their request shall be acted upon in the light of the conditions of their employment and their means of livelihood. The provisions of the second paragraph of article 1 shall apply to the renewal of the residence permit after 10 years.

Other Tunisian nationals holding residence permits who are not covered by article 1 of this Agreement may also obtain a residence permit valid for 10 years if they can provide proof of regular residence in France for a period of three years. Their request shall be acted upon in the light of the occupational or other means of livelihood of which they are able to provide proof and, where necessary, such other proof as they are able to provide in support of their request.

Such residence permits shall confer on their holders the right to engage in France in the occupation of their choice and shall be renewable as of right.

Article 4

French nationals who wish to engage in a salaried occupation in Tunisia for a period of at least one year and who are not covered by the provisions of article 2 of this Agreement shall, after undergoing a medical examination and on presentation of an employment contract stamped by the competent authorities, receive a residence permit valid for one year which shall be renewable and bear the word "salaried".

After three years of regular residence in Tunisia, the French nationals referred to in the preceding paragraph may obtain residence and work permits valid for 10 years. Their request shall be acted upon in the light of the conditions of their employment and their means of livelihood. The provisions of the second paragraph of article 2 shall apply to the renewal of the said residence and work permits after 10 years.

Other French nationals holding residence permits who are not covered by the first paragraph of article 2 of this Agreement may also obtain a residence permit valid for 10 years if they can provide proof of regular residence in Tunisia for a
