I refer to this Embassy's diplomatic note, dated September 23, 1981, informing you of the U.S. Government's intention to terminate the existing Tax Reimbursement Agreement between the U.S. Government and the World Tourism Organization,² and to replace it with a new agreement. I enclose a draft text of the new Tax Reimbursement Agreement, for your consideration.

The U.S. Government would appreciate receiving a formal response from the World Tourism Organization as soon as might be convenient.
