EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN ARRANGEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND SAINT LUCIA CONCERNING RADIO COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN AMATEUR STATIONS ON BEHALF OF THIRD PARTIES

The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of St. Lucia and has the honor to propose that an arrangement be concluded between the United States and St. Lucia to permit the exchange of third party messages between the radio amateurs of the United States and St. Lucia.

The Embassy has been authorized to submit for the consideration of the St. Lucian Government, the following proposal:

"Amateur radio stations of St. Lucia and of the United States may exchange internationally messages or other communications from or to third parties, provided:

- "1. No compensation may be directly or indirectly paid on such messages or communications.
 - "2. Such communications shall be limited to conversations or messages of a technical or personal nature for which, by reason of their unimportance, recourse to the public telecommunications service is not justified.
- To the extent that in the event of disaster,
