**BASIC AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE
FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND OF THE FRENCH
REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF
GUINEA ON THE ASSIGNMENT OF EUROPEAN VOLUN-
TEERS FOR DEVELOPMENT**

The Governments of the Federal Republic of Germany and the French Republic and the Government of the Republic of Guinea,

Desiring to consolidate the friendly relations existing between the Contracting States and their peoples,

Determined to promote cooperation between the countries of Europe and Africa,

Wishing to foster the friendship and solidarity of European and African youth,

Intent on contributing to their common economic and social development,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

(1) The Governments of the French Republic and the Federal Republic of Germany shall undertake, through the assignment of European volunteers for development, to participate in economic and social development operations which meet the priority requirements of the people of Guinea and form part of national development policy. Any participation by European volunteers for development shall be undertaken at the express request of the Government of Guinea.

(2) For the purposes of this Agreement, volunteers shall be understood to be specialists who have completed their vocational training and wish to work in the territory of the Republic of Guinea without remuneration in order to promote projects jointly agreed upon.

Article 2

(1) Each operation under this Agreement shall be the subject of a specific arrangement between its signatories.

(2) The Contracting Parties may entrust specialized agencies or bodies with the execution of this Agreement. These agencies or bodies shall, *inter alia*, if need be, be entitled to make the arrangements referred to in the first paragraph of this article. If one Party wishes to apply this provision, it shall notify the other Parties concerned accordingly.

Article 3

European volunteers for development shall be integrated into a development project under the authority of the Government of Guinea. The Governments of the French Republic and the Federal Republic of Germany, or the bodies referred to in
