EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA CONCERNING RADIO COMMUNICATION BETWEEN AMATEUR STATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE THIRD PARTIES

The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of External Affairs of Antigua and Barbuda and has the honor to propose that an arrangement be concluded between the United States and Antigua and Barbuda to permit the exchange of third party messages between the radio amateurs of the United States and Antigua and Barbuda.

The Embassy has been authorized to submit for the consideration of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda, the following proposal:

"Amateur radio stations of Antigua and Barbuda and of the United States may exchange internationally messages or other communications from or to third parties, provided:

- "1. No compensation may be directly or indirectly paid on such messages or communications.
- "2. Such communications shall be limited to conversations or messages of a technical or personal nature for which, by reason of their unimportance, recourse to the public telecommunications service is not justified.
