TREATY¹ BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA CONCERNING FRIENDSHIP AND COOPERATION

The Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea,

Finding that between the two States there exists friendship and unity based on the principles of Marxism-Leninism and socialist internationalism, respect for sovereignty, full equality, non-interference in internal affairs, fraternal cooperation, mutual relations and solidarity,

Convinced that the further strengthening and development of such relations is consistent with the fundamental interests of the people of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the people of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and will help to strengthen the unity between the socialist countries, the cause of world peace and socialism,

Proceeding from a desire to strengthen further the friendship, unity, cooperation and solidarity of the socialist countries, the non-aligned countries and other peace-loving countries of the world and to contribute actively to the strengthening of peace and security in Europe, Asia and the entire world,

Have decided to conclude this Treaty and have agreed on the following:

Article 1

The High Contracting Parties shall comprehensively deepen and develop the relations of fraternal friendship, unity and cooperation between the two States.

Article 2

The High Contracting Parties shall promote the development of cooperation between State authorities, institutions and social organizations with a view to deepening the understanding between the peoples of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, bringing them closer together, strengthening fraternal relations and creating new spiritual and material values.

Article 3

The High Contracting Parties shall expand and deepen the contacts between them and their cooperation in the areas of economics, science and technology, culture, art, education, public health, printed literature, radio, television, films and sports and in all other areas.
