MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING¹ BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF SPACE, GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDIA AND THE GENERAL ORGANISATION OF REMOTE SENSING OF THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC ON COOPERATION IN THE PEACEFUL APPLICATIONS OF REMOTE SENSING

In accordance with the interest of the Government of the Republic of India and the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic in cooperation in the peaceful applications of remote sensing techniques for the mutual benefit of both countries, the Department of Space (DOS) of India and the General Organisation of Remote Sensing (GORS) of Syria (hereinafter referred to as Parties) enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

I. In accordance with the laws and regulations in force in each country and the widely accepted international laws and rules, the Parties shall encourage exchange and cooperation in the development and use of remote sensing techniques for peaceful purposes on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

II. Cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding may include the following areas:

1. Training of scientists, engineers and technicians in the analysis, interpretation and utilization of remote sensing data for natural resources management, establishment of facilities and acquisition of equipment for reception, processing, analysis and interpretation
