MEMORANDUM¹ OF UNDERSTANDING ON COOPERATION IN
THE FIELDS OF RADIO AND TELEVISION BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF
CHINA

The Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Government of the People's Republic of China (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"),

With a view to encouraging and expanding cooperation in the fields of radio and television, and

On the basis of the principle of equality and mutual advantage,

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

RADIO

1. The Parties shall encourage the exchange of musical, cultural, informational and educational programmes between their respective radio broadcasting stations, in particular those belonging to or associated with government entities.
2. The Parties shall encourage and facilitate the reciprocal participation of the radio broadcasting companies of the two countries, by sending representatives, in the international festivals, symposia and seminars which they may promote.
3. The Parties shall support the exchange of musical programmes and shall encourage the broadcasting of programmes of Brazilian music by Chinese radio stations and of Chinese music by Brazilian radio stations.
4. The Parties shall provide technical support for the short-wave re-transmission to third countries of the programmes of their respective radio broadcasting stations, in particular those belonging to or associated with government entities.

Article II

NEWS REPORTING

The Parties shall support the exchange and the broadcasting of news reports produced by the news agencies belonging to or associated with government entities, in particular news reports concerned with aspects of the economic, social, cultural and educational life of the two countries.
